**Changing Life Chances** provides practical guidance for the recently introduced pupil premium grant aimed at helping schools to improve the life chances of children and young people from lower-income households in England. It offers examples of effective practice for how best to use the grant and is relevant also to the requirements of the Equality Act 2010.

The book distills the ideas and initiatives of the national programme known as Narrowing the Gap. Most of the projects it describes are about Derbyshire County Council's initiative as part of this programme.
